## Management Committee Minutes

1. **Confirmation of minutes of 12/03/19 Management Committee Meeting.** In the absence of any questions, it was proposed by Clytie Glass and seconded by Ross Hielscher that that the minutes be accepted. **Carried unanimously.**

2. **Treasurer's Report** presented by Clytie Glass. Motion by Julia Walkden that it be accepted, seconded by Alan. **Carried unanimously.**

### 3. Update on local development projects:

- a) Ron McCarthy reported that the council has accepted the design for his shopping centre, and has cancelled the appropriation of 4m of sidewalk.
- b) **Eastside IGA Express** plans have been lodged with council.
- c) **Intersection:** TMR is still considering our solution to the Diamond Street intersection problem. The Chamber of Commerce is potentially on board with a roundabout solution. Rod put a motion that he would write to the COC re working with CARA on roundabouts, seconded by Clytie. **Carried unanimously.**
- d) **Cooroy Hinterland Playground:** Motion by Ross Hielscher to send letter to Council, asking for information on any future planning for Cooroy done during the funding request, operational information and the report on how the location for the playground was chosen. Seconded by Duncan Macqueen and **carried unanimously.**

- e) Ray Pratt presented his plan for a **Primary School Traffic Drop-off Point** , on the western side of the railway, opposite the school, with parking on that side of the railway. Ray talked with the principal, who said that if Queensland Rail and Main Roads were ok with the idea, he'd look at it as well.
- f) Flight paths: There will be a meeting at 'The J' on Saturday. Potential for a freight hub at the airport, so not appropriate for flights to be curfewed.
- g) Bikeway from Cooroy to Tewantin: Ross Hielscher presented his bikeway proposal - a work in progress.
- h) Cooroy Transit Centre proposal: Update by Ron McCarthy, who said that Marty Hunt, Sandy Bolton, Mains Roads, and Noosa Council are agreeable. Marty will approach Queensland Rail. The transport centre proposal will be discussed with these parties soon.
- i) One Billion Rising: Reminder by Pamela Macqueen. Rod will publicise the event on the CARA website.
- j) CARA Facebook page: Now has over 1000 members.
